Toledo Sport and Social Club's Official Cornhole Rules

- 1) All tosses must be done underhand.
- 2) Cornhole games are broken down into innings. An inning consists of 8 tosses per team, 4 for each teammate.
- Before the game, the order of tossing will be determined by a round of "Paper, Rock, Scissor". The team winning this will decide if they want to toss first or second in the first inning.
- 4) Tosses alternate between teams until all 4 bags have been tossed by each player to complete the half inning.
- 5) Teams are to be directly in front of one another when playing so as to have a player tossing with the board to his/her right and the other player with the board to his/her left.
- 6) Scoring is done by cancellation scoring. A bag going through the hole is worth 3 points and a bag on the board is worth 1 point.
- 7) After each half-inning, the teams will announce the score out loud.
- 8) The team scoring points will be the team tossing first for the next half inning. If no points were scored by either team the order remains the same as the previous half inning.
- 9) Games are played until one team has reached 21 points or more. This can occur during any half inning. There are no requirements to win by 2 and there is no penalty for going over 21 points.
- 10)Scores must be reported to the TSSC representative upon completion.

Any dispute of a rule must be done prior to a game being played or if occurring during a game, it must be brought to a TSSC representative before another bag has been tossed.
